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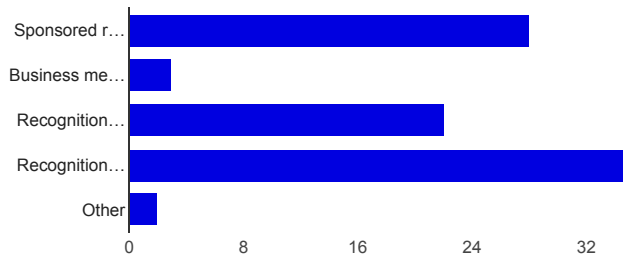

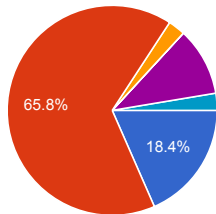

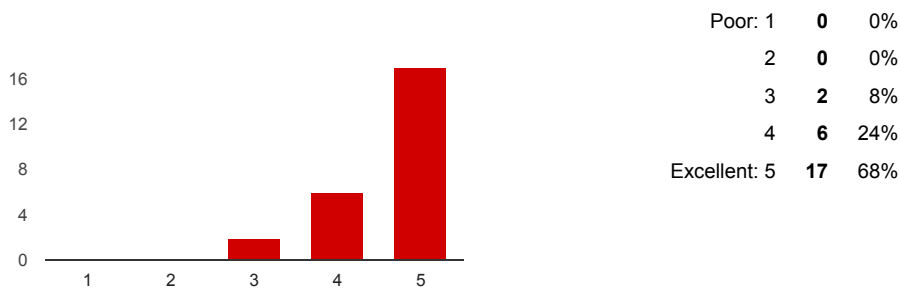
- Maybe a couple of give-aways

It seems to be working pretty well. Even though we are all at different tables, having the pizzas spread out forces everyone to get up and interact.

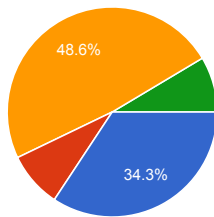
This was a very fun event, and we enjoyed the more casual atmosphere to spend time with our colleagues! Thank you for organizing!

There really isn't a way to make it more interactive - it was everything it could be!

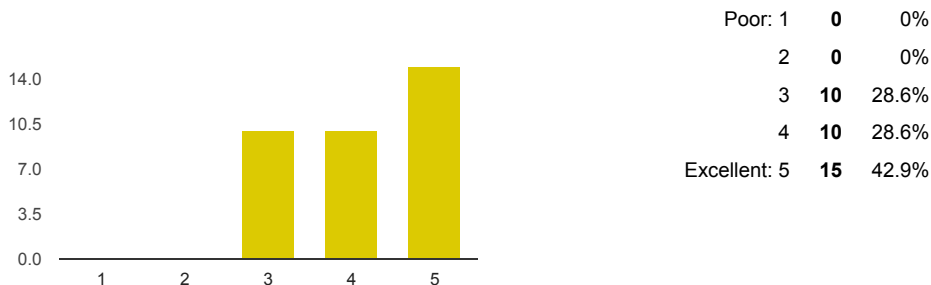
Idea...mix up seating with, I'll say it, assignments to initiate networking.

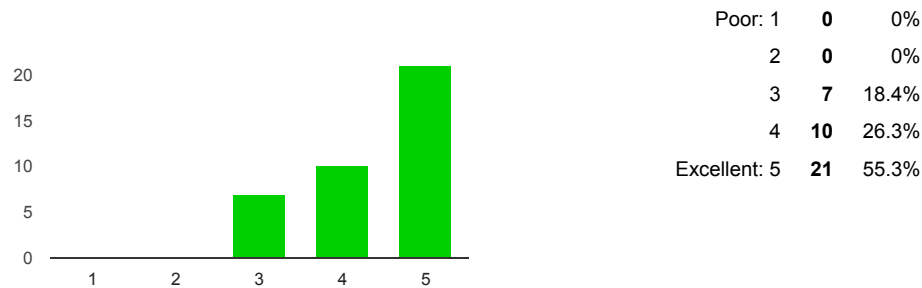
